


Lower Rates of Subscription

Annual Increase in rates of Subscription

Annual increase in rates of subscription is restricted to 5% as against the usual increase in price of e-resources from 10 to 15%.

Access to colleges to be enabled through authentication mechanism set-up at the INFLIBNET Centre

Access being enabled using EZ-Proxy (OCLC)


EZ-Proxy: Implementation and Functioning

EZproxy is a user-friendly, web-based commercial solution from OCLC (OCLC, 2010).

EZproxy is used as a mechanism to authenticate authorised users enabling them to access subscribed e-resources irrespective of their physical location.

Group login ID and passwords have been given to colleges that have not given names of their actual users




Colleges that are covered only 2F Section of UGC Act are being advised to join the initiative as N-LIST Associates
