Since a few decades Libraries have been functioning with the help of information technology. Even very small Libraries have now reconciled to the fact that they have to use a multitude of technological tools for collection development, management

and for providing user oriented quality services. But the rate at which technology is developing is mind boggling, especially for those who are not conversant with it. For example Lib 2.0 and Web 2.0 are being used to provide quality services, they also have a good impact on library websites. Mobiles enable users to have libraries in their pockets. Cloud computing, discovery tools, open content, open source software and new social networking tools are some of the most important technological changes.

It is imperative that quality services be provided to library clientele, after ascertaining their needs. Also

these services need to be periodically evaluated, by using various evaluation methods. Now the question is, in this present scenario, how can a medium sized library with limited resources provide quality services, whereby, library users are drawn to the library? Several issues involved in this

- **Emerging trends** in technology will continue to change services and required skills. It is predicted that federated search, which enabled search across multiple databases, will now be "repositioned as an embedded search, across a limited number of related resources". Again owing to Full Text Indexing of Books (Summon), there will be an increase in e-book purchases by Libraries.
- The trend of accountability and assessment has set in academic institutions. Libraries also need to demonstrate the value they provide both to their users and also to the institution. Owing to the huge growth of hand held mobile devices, most of which are internet capable, librarians need to think creatively to provide innovative services.
- Increase in collaborative initiatives, both within the staff of the institution and with other libraries will positively help to expand the role of the Library.
- Changing technology impacts both the working of the Library and also the nature of the library collection. Hence besides upgrading LIS skills, it is also important to obtain diverse skills.
- **Information Literacy** is of crucial importance. Formerly the term Information Literacy was known by different names such as Library Orientation and User Education. LIS personnel need the expertise to locate & retrieve information, so that access can be provided to information resources in all formats after ascertaining the currency and relevance.
