ABOUT THE SEMINAR

The Seminar topic is “Open Access Resources on the Internet”. Open Access has been discussed widely among LIS professionals in the recent years. The concept of Open Access emerged during early 1990s primarily to facilitate scholarly communications and gained momentum largely due to the growing financial constraints particularly in developing countries.

Open Access basically means free access to the resources on Internet, which can be used, reproduced and redistributed by the end user. Open access resources are available in various forms like, open access journals, institutional repositories, digital archives, open source code software, databases, open courseware, etc. Some of the benefits of Open Access are:

- i) Economically disadvantaged regions can have greater access to scholarly literature.
