Best Practice may be innovative and be a philosophy, policy, strategy, program, process or practice that solves a problem or creates new opportunities, which have a positive impact on organizations. This leads to institutional excellence. The best practices implemented will be discussed under the following five broad areas:

1. Management & Administration: Library and Information System Management is the basic & core activity which helps the user community in identifying and accessing knowledge resources in any institution. It also comprises of the activities performed in relation to the development of vision, mission, goals and policies of the library etc.

As the management and administration of the Library is pivotal in collection development and delivery of information products and services to the end users, adoption of best practices in this area leads to continuous improvement in overall performance.

2. Information Processing and Retrieval : Conventional and Electronic Information: The main function of the Library is to acquire or access documents, process and store the information; so that precise and pinpointed information can be easily retrieved. Libraries today provide electronic as well as traditional services.

3. Library Automation and Digital Library : Developments in information technology have introduced drastic changes in the way in which information is collected, stored, retrieved and distributed. The main responsibility of the Library is to maximize users need satisfaction and to minimize time loss to the user. Computers are used in two areas: house keeping and information retrieval.

4. Internet and Networking : A Library Network can be described as a group of Libraries coming together with some agreement to help each other with a view to satisfying the information needs of their clientele. The current networked environment enables Libraries to Create and Maintain their Websites and provide Internet Information Services.

5 Library Promotion and Marketing of Information Services and Products : Essentially promotion is the means of The essence of marketing is to find out what users want, then setting out to meet these needs.

"Best practice is known as the practice which paves the way for enhancing the existing function and helps in effective implementation or use of the process"
