## **Librarians' Day 2020**

ADINET in collaboration with National Institute of Design (NID), Ahmedabad will be conducting the seminar on 8th August 2020 at NID, Ahmedabad. The seminar is held in the commemoration of the birth anniversary of Dr.S.R.Ranganathan, Father of Library Science of India.

The theme of the seminar is Libraries, Archives and Museums (LAMs): The New Age Innovative Spaces for Academics and Research.

Libraries, Archives and Museums (LAMs) are considered as memory and cultural institutions, which not only preserve the knowledge embedded during centuries but also disseminate to connect the dots that bring stories alive, which are the real requirements for various activities especially in academics and research.

Though it is difficult to change the perception, libraries are positively regarded as just books and periodicals across the communities. It is crucial to make the users, non-users and decision makers understand that libraries offer many other diverse attractions other than books. They can provide more services when converged (digitally) with their sister institutes, the archives and museums. Together they can provide more integrated access to their collections, create very innovative spaces that offer a congenial environment for academicians and researchers. This new trend

will help in attracting the generations that are more engaged with digital medium. In future, LAMs may also lead to evolve unique institutions of 'digital heritage' and new subjects.

Hence, it is necessary to retrospect the functions/services of LAMs, in order to provide combinatorial services as per current and future research trends.

## **Archives, and Museums as learning spaces**

It is a well-known fact that archives and museums are centres for conservation and preservation of cultural and heritage materials that reflect the history. In recent days we are witnessing the contextualization of materials/ objects with past and present, thus making these spaces more conducive for academics and research.
