Since the last ten years ADINET has been covering **over 2000 Libraries & Information Centers in Gujarat**. In the last Working Group Meeting, it was decided to change the name of **ADINET to GujLibNet**.

Making any change is a very lengthy process and we have been interacting with the Charity Commissioner. We have contacted the **Founding Members of ADINET** who have expressed their desire to resign from the Governing Council which was formed in 1994. We have also obtained approval of **eleven Directors and Librarians** who have agreed to become the new GCM of ADINET

Remembering

Dr. Kautilya Shukla was a LIS teacher and professional with excellent credentials. He had obtained Ph.D. in Library and Information Science from Vikram University, Ujjain (1990).

He served various universities and libraries in Gujarat for more than 35 years as a teacher, researcher and professional in LIS. He started his career at the Public Library at Baroda and went on to become a reader of LIS at Gujarat University. He then moved to M.S. University of Baroda and became the HOD of LIS and the University Librarian of the Hansa Mehta Library at M.S. University.

He was the President of the Indian Library Association (2007-2010). He had authored 5 books and over 40 research papers in addition to guiding 4 Ph.D scholars. He had been an expert member in NET Syllabus committee of UGC and associated with 24 Universities

and higher learning institutions in the country. Dr. Shukla was recipient of the Best Librarian award (2005), Best University Library award (2006), Excellence award for IT application and Networking 2006 and Gujarat Gaurav award for Education in 2008. He had been awarded fellowship to participate in UGC/CIDA research project entitled, "A Design Model for Computerizing University" at CANADA in 1991 and had travelled to many countries including Canada, Japan, Singapore and Hong Kong. Dr. Shukla had organized LIS conferences/seminars/workshops.

Ms. Kina Khimani

Kina Khimani (1974 -2018) was the Branch Head, TCS Ahmedabad Information Resource Centre. She started her career with Paramount Pollution Control Ltd as a Chief Librarian where she defined ISO procedure for Library, Implemented all processes to obtain ISO certification as an organizational goal. After that she worked at British Library for six months and in April 1999 she joined TCS Ahmedabad.

She was a very good leader with excellent library management skills and was very creative and an energetic person. She was an inspiration for all juniors in a team and had groomed all of them to work in a corporate culture.

She was passionate and enthusiastic towards work and hence her illness had not affected the quality of her work till the end. She was awarded for best Event Management skills for celebrating IRC Information Resource Centre Week in 2006. Under her leadership team was awarded as 'Star Team Award' in 2015 for conducting an internal Annual Leadership Meet. She participated in expert talk sessions and presentations during her tenure were:

1. Value Added Services at British Council Library in 2011-12.
2. Recent Library Trends: Marketing Library Products and Services in 2014 for a Refresher course at Gujarat University.
3. Invited talk on Service level Agreement and Library standards at Gujarat Power Engineering & Research Institute in 2018.

She will be always remembered by TCS, IRC community for her passion for work & enthusiasm.

The Seminar theme is Future Libraries – Overcoming Challenges

In order to discuss the Future of Libraries, it is essential to study the present emerging trends in libraries, since libraries are important hubs for learning and knowledge creation. These trends vary to a major extent from library to library, that is from School Libraries, up to Libraries of Institutions of Higher Learning.

The huge gap in the resources available in different categories of libraries can to a large extent be addressed by implementing the following:-

- Resource Sharing
- Networking of Libraries by Subject & by Category
- Co-operative Cataloging
- Introducing C.I.P. Data

Information Technology is being extensively used in most libraries and there is no debate about the need to use new technology as and when it is developed.

Sub-theme 1. Use of New Information Technology in Future Libraries

Libraries are constantly evolving to meet the diverse needs of their users. To do this they need to focus on new emerging technologies, which are both innovative and relevant.

Libraries serve as invaluable resources from providing crucial information to providing help in using new technology. They can serve as critical access points to new technology some of which are listed below:-

- **Gamification** is an emerging trend that can be used from elementary school education to professional training.
- **Data Analytics** helps to analyze the huge amount of digital data in order to find meaningful conclusions from the data.
- **Internet of things** is the network of devices and appliances that contain electronics, software and connectivity which allows these things to connect and interact.

Sub-theme 2. Rethinking Role of Libraries in National Development

The focus of our Government is on Digital India. It will help to transform India into a digitally empowered society, in which libraries can play a powerful role; hence there are many programs like Startup India, E-kranti, and Information for All and some more.

Where **Startups** are concerned, the thousands of Startups have made a really good impact. Even L.I.S. Professionals have initiated Startups in their libraries.

e-Kranti is an essential pillar of the Digital India initiative. Even though its vision is to transform e-Governance, it has several objectives which could be useful for libraries. Another Digital India initiative is **Information for All**. In this program online hosting of information and documents would facilitate open and easy access to information for citizens.

Sub-theme 3. Providing Innovative Services

L.I.S. Professionals have to actively engage with the community as they do have a social responsibility. They need to have Community Based Activities and Outreach Programs.

In some libraries, spaces are developed to connect people, to enable them to come together & work together, to learn, to share and participate in projects like **Maker Space** which enables innovation and knowledge exchange. Even **digital hubs** are created to give varied services. "Creating is now becoming a new digital competency".

Establishing, maintaining and growing a **Social Media** presence is very important for libraries, as it helps to engage with users, strengthen social connections, market library services & also helps to change the poor advocacy that exists in some libraries.
