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
Dear LIS Professionals.

GUIDELINES FOR POSTER PRESENTATION

All current LIS students (BLIS, MLIS, Ph.D.) from different Departments and Schools within Gujarat are eligible to submit a poster. Only one poster per student will be accepted.

Measurements:

Posters should be prepared in A1 size (33.1x23.4 inches). It can be in portrait or landscape orientation.

Content and design:

All posters on any of the themes and sub-themes should include the title, name of authors, and institution. Content must be original. The poster will be disqualified if found plagiarized. Poster can be prepared in any of the

following languages: English, Hindi, and Gujarati.

The lettering of the title should be at least 25 mm high and the main text at least 10 mm high.

The poster should be easily readable from a distance of 2 meters. The soft copy of the poster must be submitted by email for selection: alibnet@gmail.com. Posters fulfilling the above criteria will be evaluated and selected for display and presentation. Printed copy will be required if selected for display at the Conference Venue. Seminar Organizers will provide the space and equipment for setting up the posters on the boards. The poster will be available for viewing by participants during all hours of the event.

Presentation:

Each poster presenter will be given an opportunity to present their poster content during a specific allotted time. Each presenter will be allowed approximately 5 minutes for the presentation. The time allowed for the presentation is subject to change depending on the number submissions. Presenters will be notified of changes in advance. All participants are encouraged to visit the posters during the breaks and contact the main author during the seminar.



Information Science Professionals and also to researchers.


IMPORT RECORDS FROM UNICAT TO KOHA USING Z39.50

Step: -1 Login into Koha LMS

Go to the cataloging module > click on New from Z39.50 SRU tab



Step: -2 Search the records from Union Catalogue tab and find the records from SRU, Search can be done by ISBN, Author, title etc.



Step: -3 Click on action tab and import the records into your Koha LMS.
